#### PRE-SHOW DETAILS: DANCER CHECK-IN (BACKSTAGE)

Upon arrival, please follow the "DANCER CHECK-IN" Signs. This will lead you to where the dancers will be held during the show.

#### ONLY ONE PARENT ALLOWED DURING CHECK-IN!

Parent/Guardian will receive a wristband for dancer check-in/out

ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE SHOW!

#### **CHECK-OUT DETAILS: PARENT PICKUP AFTER PERFORMANCE**

Dancers can only be checked out during the following times:

- 1. INTERMISSION (If your dancer's number has been performed)
- 2. END OF SHOW (once the show has concluded)

#### **V** PARENT REMINDERS:

- ONLY ONE PARENT ALLOWED DURING CHECK OUT!
- Parent must have the **RED** wristband to check out their dancer
- Please <u>DO NOT</u> bring your entire family to the checkout table! You will
  be asked to step out of the line until the proper protocol is followed.

#### √ PARENT CHECK-IN REMINDERS:



- Place the RED wristband on provided for you AND your dancer BEFORE arrival to the event.
- Take your dancer to the bathroom

- Only ONE Parent allowed during CHECK-IN/OUT!
- Parents should prepare for immediate departure after check-in.
- Please do not hang around backstage.Grab a seat for the show (doors open: 4:30 P.M.)

#### √ HAIR & MAKE-UP

- HAIR: Pulled back in a neat bun
- MAKE-UP: Applied BEFORE Dancer Check-In

#### **√ NO CELL PHONES BACKSTAGE**

- Cell phones and tablets are NOT allowed backstage.
- All forms of social media are prohibited backstage.
- NO POLISH OR JEWELRY should be worn during performance. Rhinestone Performance earrings only.

#### SHOW RUN-THRU /STAGE REHEARSAL

**Save the Date!** All performers participating in the showcase must attend the show run-thru rehearsal scheduled on **Friday**, **December 12<sup>th</sup>** held inside the Berman Center for the Performing Arts. Parents will be provided a "walk thru" of protocols that students and parents alike must follow. Dancers will also participate in a practice run of their dance number(s) on the stage.

- Classes will have assigned arrival times, to help keep the stage rehearsals running smoothly.
- Dancers will be dismissed immediately following their stage run thru.

#### **COSTUMES NOT NEEDED AT STAGE REHEARSAL!**

Costumes are not required for the Stage rehearsal. However, please bring your dance shoes, bottled water and dress in comfortable dance class attire. We'll have all class props from the studio on site at the pavilion for the show run thru to ensure our showcase runs smoothly.

#### **EXTRA/EXTENDED REHEARSALS**

As our showcase draws near there may be a need for select classes to have extra/extended rehearsal time(s) to help ensure our dancers are prepared, confident and ready to perform. An email notification will be dispersed in November advising which classes require extra/extended class time before our actual show run thru.





#### **PERFORMANCE COSTUMES**



Costume participation forms were distributed in October so parents may see what's required to participate in the upcoming Holiday showcase. All dancers participating in the Holiday Showcase will be required to wear a costume. Each dancer's body measurements were taken during class time to ensure the appropriate costume size is ordered.

#### **COSTUME REMINDERS**

- COSTUMES: Available and distributed no later than the week of December 8th.
- BACKORDERS: If there is an issue concerning back-ordered costumes, parents will be notified immediately of alt costume selections.
- ALTERATIONS: Some costumes may need alternations, which you should have finished before
  the show. If you need alterations, we recommend visiting your local tailor/cleaners.
- <u>UNDERGARMENTS:</u> Female dancers should avoid wearing underwear underneath their
  performance costume. Please just wear your tights and costume. If you have any reservations
  regarding this, we recommend you purchase proper dance undergarments that are either nude or
  black. Male dancers should also wear black undergarments underneath their costume as well.

#### HAIR, TIGHTS & SHOES

All dancers participating in the Holiday Showcase are required to have the appropriate hair, tights and shoes assigned to their respective classes.

- HAIR: All dancers should have their hair in a neat bun for the show (slick or braided)
- <u>TIGHTS:</u> All dancers should have a brand NEW pair of performance tights ready for the stage (applicable to those classes that wear tights). Tights will be available for sale at the studio prior to recital (cash only).
- SHOES: All dancers should be wearing the assigned class shoe for performance. No "alternative" shoes are permitted. (Please see shoe order forms for reference/links)
  - BALLET: Pink ballet tights, Pink ballet slippers
  - **JAZZ:** Black Fishnet Tights, Black Jazz shoes
  - HIP HOP (GIRLS): Black Sequin Hi-Tops
  - HIP HOP (BOYS): Black/White Converse style Hi-Tops

#### **POLISH & JEWELRY**

- No fingernail pollish should be worn on hands or feet during performance.
- No fashion earrings should be worn. Rhinestone Performance earrings only.

#### **HOLIDAY SHOWCASE PROTOCOLS**

#### **CODE OF CONDUCT FORM**

All dancers <u>must</u> have a signed Code of Conduct form signed by their Parent/Guardian and on file prior to the December 13<sup>th</sup> Holiday Showcase.

- Please review all details on the form and initial next to each statement indicating that you understand the protocols required to participate in the show.
- Forms will be available in the studio November thru December. Please place signed copies in the tray on the information table.

#### PARENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO STAY IN THE DRESSING ROOMS OR BACKSTAGE

Unless you are a staff member or designated volunteer. There will be staff members, volunteers and caregivers assigned to the dancers to ensure that all performers are accounted for.

- No one under the age of 18 will be able to leave the dressing room without a parent.
- Please be sure to volunteer with us and we'll assign you a specific role if you desire to be backstage.
- The volunteer sign-up form is included in this packet. Background checks must be approved first. (See Holiday Showcase Hub online for process overview)



**NOTE:** Dancers displaying any behavioral issues backstage will be asked to sit with their parents in the audience until performance time.

#### WHAT HAPPENS ONCE I DROP MY DANCER OFF?

- 1. Once dancers are checked-in with the rest of their class, they will place their bags and/or costumes down in their respective areas.
- 2. Instructors will then provide warm-up exercises for all dancers in prep for the show.
- 3. Coloring pages, books and activities will be available for backstage to keep dancers busy until their designated performance time.

#### **SNACKS AND GAMES**

Snacks will be provided backstage. Dancers may bring their own "Clean Snacks" ex. water, crackers, cheese. (No chocolate, potato chips or other messy snacks please).

PLEASE NOTE: NO snacks are allowed that contain any type of nut products in them such as PEANUT, COCONUT AND TREE NUTS. Snacks containing these ingredients will be discarde

#### **HELPFUL HINTS**

- Pack bags two nights before. The night before everyone needs their rest so plan ahead and pack a couple days in advance.
- Remain calm. Performances can cause nerves for both parents and dancers! Help each other by speaking nicely to one another in the dressing room.
- If you have quick changes the staff will plan who is going to help you. There are lots of hands to help.
- Quick changes work best when all your costume pieces, tights and shoes are laid out. That way you aren't searching for items.
- Have fun and enjoy your performance and the experience of being in a show! These are memories you will cherish forever:)
